## CHAPTER 135.

An Act to Incorporate the Directors of Sainte-Anne College, Church Point, and to enable them to confer Degrees with the Act of Amendment of 1893.

(First Act passed the 30th day of April, A. D. 1892.)

## SECTION.

- 1. Incorporation.
- 2. Perpetual Succession, Seal, etc.
- 3. Who eligible to be members.
- 4. Appointment of President, etc.
- 5. College to be a University, Degrees, etc.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GOVERNOR, COUNCIL AND ASSEMBLY, AS FOLLOWS:---

- The Reverend Gustave Blanche, Reverend Joseph Haquin, Reverend Francois Ozanne, Reverend Aimé Morin and Reverend Philéas F. Bourgeois, A. M. of Church Point, in the County of Digby, shall be a body corporate by the name of "The Directors of Sainte-Anne College, Church Point."
- 2. The Corporation hereby created shall have perpetual succession and a common seal and shall have power to fill any vacancy occurring therein from death, resignation or permanent removal from the Province of Nova Scotia or other cause, and may increase their number by electing additional members.
- 3. No person shall be appointed a member of said corporation who is not in communion with the Roman Catholic Church, and any person ceasing to be in communion with the said Roman Catholic Church shall cease to be a member of the corporation hereby created.
