

But if this work of the press is a less task, then, it might be asked, why it that the Church commands the reading and insists upon the explanation of the Gospel in the year after year?

Aside, however, from this consideration, those who are sufficiently familiar with the requirements of Lent, with further reminder from the pulpit, the press, should bear in mind that the Lenten season is the season of the places where the priest seldom goes, where the Gospel is rarely preached. In this it is doing the work of clergy, imperfectly, of course, but zealously enough, in helping the faithful to obtain sufficiently bright salvation. Surely, this is ample justification for the custom.
