TO DESTROY INSECTS IN STORED GRAIN.

Grain is sometimes subject to depredations from the flying weevil or grey moth, which develops and matures in the heart of the grain, and which imparts considerable heat to the bulk of the grain.

TO PRESERVE EGGS.

To every gallon of water allow one heaped gill of unslacked lime, and one pint of rock salt. Strain the lime by pouring on the water, but add the salt, when it is perfectly cold, put in the eggs, taking care that every bad or cracked one is kept out, or the whole will be spoiled.
