Saturday *June 18th*, 1768.

The House being met, *Charles Dickson*, Esq; returned a Member for the Township of *Horton*, took the Oaths and his Seat accordingly.

Gentlemen of the Council, and House of Assembly,

“ THE present Season, to which you were
“ prorogued, being the most convenient, I
“ have therefore thought proper now to meet you.

“ The principal Matters I have to recommend
“ to your Consideration, are to provide Supplies
“ for the Support, and necessary Expences of Go-
“ vernment, for the present Year.

“ To examine into the State of the public Funds,
“ and
