THE WORLD'S WEALTH. Interesting Figures Compiled by a United States Mining Director. The Director of the United States Mines, Washington, reports that the value of the gold deposited at the mint and sold during the fiscal year was \$7,462,000, of which \$5,151,007 were original deposits and \$2,310,993 were re-deposits.

The average price of silver bullion during the year was 22 pence, equivalent to 63 cents. The highest price was during the year was 63 cents, and the lowest price 53 cents. At the average price of silver bullion during the year, the ratio of gold to silver was 1 to 15.5.

The estimated product of gold and silver in the United States during the calendar year 1894 was: Gold \$9,500,000 and silver \$1,200,000, or a total of \$10,700,000. The value of the gold and silver estimated to have been used in the industrial arts during the year was \$1,000,000.
