### Friests Should Study Science.

The aspirants for the priesthood must acquire their knowledge of science in the seminary if they require it at all, writes Rev. J. A. Zum in Donahoe's Magazine for September. The elementary knowledge which they get in the public schools or gain by general reading, will serve them but little when they are called upon to discuss the great questions of religion which in our day are considered to be of such paramount importance. Certain questions in Astronomy, geology, paleontology, biology, ethnology, archaeology they must study not cursorily and superficially, but carefully and profoundly, if they would hope to cope with their candidates with any hope of success.

### NEW VERSES BY HIS HOLINESS.

### Roman Notes.

The indefatigable pastoral zeal of the Holy Father has manifested itself in another Pontifical utterance addressed to the Mexican hierarchy. It concerns the national sanctuary of Our Lady of Guadalupe, the world-famed madonna whose history of grace and favor reaches back to the time of the foundation of Mexican Catholicism. A few years ago the Pope ordered it to be crowned and he has now acceded to the petition of the hierarchy by granting a proper office for its feast.

### Catholic Schools in Manitoba.

On the 11th inst, monstrous gathering of the Catholics of Winnipeg and surrounding country marched in a body to the Government building to lay before the Ministers their petition for the re-establishment of Separate Schools. The deputation was received by Messrs. Greenway, Cameron and McMillan. After the petition had been read Mr. Greenway promised to return a written answer in a few days.

### Duke Of Orleans.

From the moment the mantle of the Comte de Paris falls on the shoulders of the Duke of Orleans, writes the Paris correspondent of the Times, the French Republic will have to face the most serious antagonist it has yet encountered. The Comte de Chambard, wrapped up in his white flag, was impossible under modern conditions of French life. The Comte de Paris with his mind undecided between his own and the people's rights, was also an enemy scarcely to be feared.
