The late Liberal government owed its overthrow nainly to the trade hostility which was created by the earnest efforts of Sir William Harcourt, to introduce scheme of legislation which would have interfered with the profits of the liquor trade. Lord Peel, who as I have said, was president of the Commission to inquire into the whole subject, drew up with hisown hand a minority report, as it was called—a report embodying the views and recommendations of those members of the Commission who thought with him. There was nothing extravagant or even immoderate, there was nothing impracticable or fanciful in the recommendations of Lord Peel.
