## SYSTEM OF WIRELESS

A project for establishing a system of wireless telegraphy between British Columbia and New Zealand and Australia is being considered by the British government. It is the outgrowth of a proposition to connect the various British islands in the South Pacific. F. J. Cross, an American electrical enr. J.
