A FATAL VISIT TO A HENCOOP.

A HIRER MAN'S TOO READY USE OF FIREARMS.

A Well-Known Resident of Ontario County shot dead on suspicion of being a chicken thief - An Early Morning Tragedy at Ricketing Village - Two Men in Custody.

The residents of Ricketing were startled yesterday to hear that William Palmer, a resident of Frenchman's Bay, had been shot dead by Henry Lingford at Ricketing village at 3 a.m. Some time past Mr. Baker has been bothered with chicken thieves and on several occasions has had fowls stolen. While passing up the lane Lingford, Baker's hired man, fired his revolver twice after the retreating figure. Mr. Lingford was after firing the second time and states that the fellow came back and threatened him. Fearing that he would be shot he fired a third time when the fellow dropped in the mud, and going close around the shot had been fatal, death having been instantaneous.

County Constable Decker was sent for and recognized the body as that of William Palmer, a poor fellow whose greatest fault was his appetite for liquor.

Coroner Bateman was notified and upon arrival issued a warrant for an inquest. Messrs. Baker and Lingford were placed under arrest and a jury, with Isaac Lincoln as foreman, was empanelled.

Farwell, Q.C., is looking after the case for the crown, while Theodore McGillivray, LL.B., is present on behalf of the prisoners.

Much sympathy is felt for the friends of the deceased, as he is well connected. Mr. Palmer's family being one of the most respected in the township. The prisoners are also men of integrity and it is generally supposed that the shooting was done merely to scare the thief.

The inquest has been adjourned till Monday night.

The prisoners are out on bail.

COMPARED TO MARY MAGDALENE.

PARIS, Nov. 16.—The appeal of Mrs. Deacon from the decision of the Tribunal de Seine, declaring she had no right to apply for a divorce from her husband and awarding the custody of the children to Mr. Deacon, came before the Tribunal de la Cour de Appel. He would himself rather choose a standard which depreciated but led to a rise in price rather than a standard which appreciated."

Senator Jones added: "These are sound views, which the United States is ready to accept."
