MARRIED, 4 January, the Rev. John-Charles-Hillier Mockridge, Rector of the Church of the Messiah, Detroit, son of the Rev. Charles-Henry Mockridge, D.D., to Beatrice, dau. of the Hon. Featherston Osler, Justice of the Court of Appeal for Ontario. (*Ontarian Families*, i, 84.)

MARRIED, 5 January, at Halifax, Nova Scotia, Capt. John Craske, of the Prince of Wales' Leinster Regt. Royal Canadians, only son of the late Deputy Inspector-General C.-B. Craske, Madras Army, to Clara-Grace, only dau. of Surgeon-General William-Silver Oliver. (*Ontarian Families*, ii., 139).

MARRIED, 1st February, Overton F. Macdonald, M.D., to Adelaide, dau. of the late Robert Sullivan. (*Ontarian Families*, ii., 45).

DIED, 1st December 1898, Maria-Louisa, widow of the late Henry-Edward-Hamilton Nelles of Grimsby, aged 55. (*Ontarian Families*, ii. 155)

DIED, 10 December, John Secord, Q.C., of Regina, sometime member of the Legislative Assembly of the North-West Territories. Mr. Secord m. April 1875, Ida-May, dau. of John-Christopher Ingersoll, who predeceased him by a few months. (*Ontarian Families*, ii. 86).

DIED, 13 December, Charles-Colmore Grant, 7th Baron de Longueuil. Baron Grant having left no issue is succeeded by his brother, Reginald-d'Iberville-Charles Grant, who was b. 1856, and m. 1891, Kate-Isobel, dau. of John Church of Carfin, Co. Lanark, Sco.

DIED, 15 December, Alexander Grant, Registrar of the Court of Appeal for Ontario, aged 85. (*Ontarian Families*, i., 38).
