ches, Auction Man.; F. I. Weaver, Librarian; R. S. Mason, and Geo. W. Hicks, Trustees; W. A. Starnaman, Bus. Mgr. of the PHILATELIC ADVOCATE, and a number of the members of the Toronto Stamp Club.

Communications were read from: F. J. Garracy, Count. Det.; E. L. Shove, Exch. Supt.; J. A. Wainwright, Attorney; R. G. Widdicombe, Ac. and Sub. Agent; expressing regret at being unable to be present at the meeting.

After considerable discussion concerning an Official Emblem it was moved and seconded that Mr. R. S. Mason, of Hamilton, Ont., be given the sole right to sell the buttons submitted by him at Hamilton.

Two new rules were added to the Auction Department, viz: (1) All lots valued over twenty-five cents must be registered at expense of buyer, if he does not care to pay registration, lots are to be sent at buyer's risk. (2.) No lots are to be offered for sale unless they are in the hands of the Auction Manager.

It was voted that the Society pay the expenses of the hall.
