General Summary.

The Chinese at home are great tobacco smokers, they use exclusively the native grown weed.

The Toronto Silver Plate Co. denies that it has any intention of opening a retail store in this city as was reported.

The value of the export of forest products from Canada during November was \$2,355,629, the total exports for the month being \$15,435,537.

The Hon. John Costigan, the new Minister of Marine and Fisheries, presides over a department that disburses \$1,500,000 per annum, and has over 1000 men in its employ.

According to the San Francisco "Bulletin," California is now apprehensive of being overrun by the Japanese, as the new treaty gives the people of each nation the right of free entry into the other. The "Bulletin" believes that "Japanese immigration is more threatening than the Chinese."

The project for the organization of the manufacturers of the United States into a compact body for the advancement of trade is meeting with success. The movement was inaugurated under the auspices of the Manufacturers' Association of Cincinnati, which arranged for a national convention of manufacturers to be held in Cincinnati on January 22, and a large and representative attendance is assured.

The pier head at Liverpool is to be directly connected with N. W. Railway. This is good news to travellers.

The Winnipeg Jewellers' Association claims to have led the way in having all watch cases properly stamped. The trade should follow suit.

The Christmas trade in the States has been a poor one, but signs of improvement are seen in the increased number of hands employed, and a falling off in number of failures compared to same date 1893.

The weekly statement of the Bank of France shows the following changes, as compared with the previous accounts: Notes in circulation, increased 25,700,000; treasury accounts, current, increased 19,075,000; gold in hand increased 12,575,000; bills discounted, increased 34,825,000; silver in hand, decreased 150,000.

The General Colonization Society of Province of Quebec has elected the following officers: Patrons of the society, His Grace Archbishop Fabre and Hon. J. A. Chapleau, lieutenant-governor of Quebec; J. D. Rolland, president, Judge de Montigny, first vice-president, Chevalier Ed. de Bellefeuille, Adm. Jos. Brunet, Emile Marquette, R. Bollenmar, L. E. Beauchamp, T. Bertaume, committee, Dr. Brisson, managing director I. F. Caruel, secretary, Joseph Blain, treasurer.

The Chambre de Commerce decided after some discussion at its last meeting to recommend the appointment of a committee of specialists in the different industries of the country to make a particular study of Canadian products which it would be most advantageous to export. A delegation might then be sent to Europe at the expense of the Dominion Government. Thus on the line of policy we have commended elsewhere in a notice of wine exports from Australia.
