

increased rate of return. The 0.35¢/lb duty on frozen mackerel will be reduced to zero. Smoked or kippered herring, currently carrying a tariff of 0.3¢/lb, will go to free, as will canned herring not in oil which now has a duty of 0.5¢/lb. Crabmeat, prepared or preserved, not canned, will have its tariff reduced from 7.5 to 5 percent. Exports of canned salmon to the United States will benefit from tariff reductions from 7.5 to 3 percent. The competitiveness of yellow perch will be increased when the U.S. 1.5¢/lb duty is eliminated, a concession of considerable interest to the Great Lakes fishery.
