

66. The two Parties will continue to exchange information material, books, and other publications in various areas relating to education and culture; these will be provided through the two countries' respective embassies.

67. The Canadian side indicated that the Biblioteca Nacional de México [National Library of Mexico] holds the status of affiliate of the National Library of Canada, and that any ministry or other agency of the Mexican Government may, through the Biblioteca Nacional de México, receive copies of any documents made available to that library by the Canadian Government.

Mexico expressed its thanks for this information.

68. The SEP's Dirección General de Materiales Didácticos y Culturales [Educational and Cultural Materials Branch] expressed its wish to exchange informational and educational material for children from six to 14 years of age. For this purpose, the SEP would provide a set of the "El Capitán Magister" books, which are used as an instructional aid for primary-school education in Mexico.

The Canadian side took note of this.

Contacts will be made through diplomatic channels.

69. The SEP and the Canadian Organisation for Development through Education (CODE) will continue to exchange publications from time to time.

70. The two Parties will continue their programme for the exchange of sets of books.
