EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS AMENDING AND EXTENDING THE AGREEMENT ON FISHERIES CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES SIGNED JANUARY 22, 1971

EXCELLENCY,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics on co-operation in fisheries in the northeastern Pacific Ocean off the coast of Canada, done at Moscow on January 22, 1971, in two copies, each in the English, French and Russian languages, each text being equally authentic, and to the meeting of representatives of the two Governments held in Ottawa from February 5 to 8, 1973, and to propose, on behalf of the Government of Canada, that the Agreement continue in force from February 19, 1973, and remain in force for two years, and that the additions contained in the attached Annex be incorporated therein and become an integral part of the Agreement.

I have the honour to propose that this Note together with its Annex, in English and in French, and your Excellency's reply in Russian, shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments, the English, French and Russian versions of which shall be equally authentic, to continue as amended the Agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics on co-operation in fisheries in the northeastern Pacific Ocean off the coast of Canada, done at Moscow on January 22, 1971, which shall enter into force on February 19, 1973.

Accept, Excellency, the renewed assurances of my highest consideration.
