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MINISTER PETERSON TO LEAD TRADE MISSION TO CHINA

From January 18 to 25, International Trade Minister Jim Peterson will lead a trade mission to China to help enhance Canada's relationship with China and to bring together Canadian and Chinese business people. Approximately 375 delegates from 280 companies and government departments and agencies will travel with the Minister to this emerging market.

During the mission, the Minister will deliver speeches in Beijing, Shanghai and Hong Kong. Prime Minister Paul Martin will join Minister Peterson in both Beijing and Hong Kong.
