VISIT TO CANADA OF
HIS EXCELLENCY JOZSEF MARJAI
DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER OF THE
HUNGARIAN PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC
OCTOBER 19-31, 1985

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Right Honourable Joe Clark, announced today that the Deputy Prime Minister of the Hungarian People's Republic, His Excellency Mr. Jozsef Marjai will visit Canada from October 19-31. Mr. Marjai will visit Toronto, Vancouver, Edmonton, Calgary, Ottawa, Montreal and Quebec.

Mr. Marjai will meet with Mr. Clark in Vancouver on October 23 to discuss a wide range of bilateral and multilateral issues. The talks will deal with major issues of East-West relations as well as with international economic questions. The remainder of the visit will focus largely on commercial matters.

In Ottawa, Mr. Marjai will meet with the Minister for International Trade, The Honourable James Kelleher.

Canada's bilateral relations with Hungary have progressed well and the forthcoming visit will promote further cooperation in a number of areas.
