VISIT TO OTTAWA OF U.S. SECRETARY OF STATE

GEORGE P. SHULTZ

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Right Honourable Joe Clark, today announced that he and the United States Secretary of State, the Honourable George P. Shultz, will hold their regular quarterly consultations on major bilateral and international issues in Ottawa, on January 11.

Their discussions are expected to include the Free Trade Agreement, acid rain, Arctic cooperation, the Toronto Economic Summit, the Multilateral Trade Negotiations, East/West relations and arms control, Central America, and South Africa.

The visit of Mr. Shultz will also be the occasion for the signing of declarations or agreements on Arctic cooperation, counter terrorism and extradition.
