The program for the current year has been expanded to include not only the physician and surgeon but also the eye specialist who made the trip last year, a dentist, and laboratory and x-ray facilities, including technician. In addition to the regular patrol and the *Nascopie* a medical officer of the service will travel by coastal schooner to the posts on Ungava Bay where there are about 900 Eskimos. These are not visited regularly as the *Nascopie* does not go down into the Bay.

8. The Canadian Government icebreaker *N. B. McLean* will again be carrying a physician into the Strait and down the east coast of Hudson Bay as far as Port Harrison.
