

these new discoveries of oil. What the previous hon. member said about Alberta could well prove true for the whole of Canada. We ought to handle our national heritage as Alberta has handled its resources. We need to fear no spectres of American domination of our oil fields if we handle our own resources as they ought to be handled. There is no reason why, in developing the north, the people of Canada cannot utilize the same techniques of government controlled free enterprise which made Alberta prosperous in the last decade. As has been carefully pointed out, we own that oil that is still undiscovered. Nevertheless, it is there. What we need is a shot in the arm which the government could provide.

Mr. Nielsen: A new government.

Mr. Bigg: I hope that the government is thinking of going to the people. I sincerely hope it will do that, and the sooner the better.
