WAR TAX POSTAGE

Circulars, catalogues, newspapers, parcels, etc., are not subject to the war tax.

A "War Tax" of one cent has been imposed on each letter and post card mailed in Canada for delivery in Canada, the United States, Mexico and letters to United Kingdom and British possessions generally, and wherever the two cent rate applies.

The "War Tax" is to be prepaid by the senders by means of a war stamp or postage stamp. In the event of failure on the part of the sender to prepay the war tax on each letter or post card, such letter or post cards will be sent immediately to the Branch Dead Letter Office.
