MRS. FYSHE'S SUDDEN DEATH

Montreal Woman Passes Away at St. George-Street House.

The very sudden death of Mrs. Fyshe, wife of Thomas Fyshe, general manager of the Merchants Bank of Canada at Montreal, occurred at 2.30 o'clock yesterday afternoon at the residence of H. C. McLeod, 130 St. George-street, where she was visiting. Although she had been ill for several days the sudden termination was entirely unlooked for and a great shock to her friends.

On Sunday night Mrs. Fyshe came up from Montreal with her daughter, Miss Anna Fyshe, the brilliant young pianist, who appeared at the Plunket Greene concert in Massey Hall on Monday night. Mrs. Fyshe was taken ill on the train. She was attended by Dr. Scadding, Caven and McPherson. Besides her husband she leaves six children, three boys and three girls. She was the only daughter of Mrs. Leon Owens, recently of Montreal, a literary woman of considerable note, who lived for years in India and Spain, and whose works on the people of those countries are well known and widely read.

ROSSLYN WILLING TO PAY.

Was a Recipient of a Loan at the Hands of Great Britain.

London, May 2.—In the House of Lords to-day, the Earl of Rosslyn, who served with Thorneycroft's Horse in South Africa, and acted as war correspondent for a newspaper, questioned the government on the subject of the money distributed to British prisoners of war at Pretoria early in 1900 by the late Adolphe S. Hay, when he was United States Consul at Pretoria. The Earl said he had a personal interest in the matter since, if the money was intended as a gift, he was entitled to a share of it, as a prisoner of war.

An Advance, Not a Gift.

The Under Secretary for War, Lord Raglan, replied that no particular suggestions in regard to the distribution of the money were sent to Mr. Hay. The money was merely an advance, as it was presumed the prisoners would be in want of money. It was left to Mr. Hay to dispose of the funds as it seemed best to him. Certain civilians, including the noble Earl, who raised the question, had been recipients of the funds.

Asked for Repayment.

Lord Rosslyn having intimated that he considered the money to be a gift, the War Secretary, Lord Lansdowne, with some warmth, remarked that the money was intended as an advance to officers, and that the amounts paid to civilians were paid on the understanding that they would be repaid. Other recipients, more entitled to public generosity, had repaid the money without complaint. Lord Rosslyn had been applied to for repayment by the government, which did not know its man.

Was Secretary Surprised.

The noble Lord replied that it was scandalous to ask for repayment. He was surprised to find the government asking for repayment of the money. The War Secretary was surprised that Lord Rosslyn should wish to have the fact proclaimed.

Lord Rosslyn, in reply, claimed that his position was entirely right.

He said the War Office wanted the £25 (£125) advanced to him it could have it.

NIAGARA TO SUPPLANT COAL.

Lord Kelvin Sees the Beginning of a New Era.

Rochester, May 2.—"I regard Niagara Falls as the greatest problem in America for scientists to solve," said Lord Kelvin on his arrival here yesterday from Buffalo. "The time is coming when coal and oil will be too scarce and too expensive to be used for the manufacture of power. There is at Niagara Falls an inexhaustible supply of power that in fifty or a hundred years is bound to be utilized to its fullest extent."

"I predict the time will come when the water will no longer flow over the great Horseshoe Falls, but that the same water will find its way down to the river below through countless turbines, spreading light and power for the use of millions of persons in all sections of the country."

"This world must depend on its water for power in the future. America has millions upon millions of horse-power in connection with her rivers that are utterly neglected. This power is bound to be developed in the near future. The start that has been made at Niagara Falls will be only the beginning of a new era in the manufacture and transmission of power."

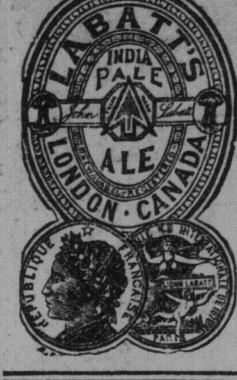
