MINES DISPLAYED
STEADY TENDENCY

Bar Silver's Jump to High Re-
cord Inspired No Response
in Cobalt Stocks.

Owing to the closing of all American
markets on the anniversary of Lin-
coln's birthday yesterday, trading in
the mining market was light in vol-
ume, with fluctuations very narrow.

Business was on this account suspended
in the afternoon session.

The most important news was the
jump in the price of silver to a new
high record since 1893.

The previous
high level was reached last week at
77 1/2, but yesterday's quotation at 78 1/2
eclipsed this by a substantial margin.

A feature of the market has been the
total failure of the silver stocks to
show any appreciation of the con-
tinued strength in silver which has
been evidenced by its rising tendency.

Since the middle of January, when the
lowest point since November was
touched at 74 1/2, the price has gradu-
ally advanced to yesterday's high level.

The Cobalt stocks have not as yet
made any responsive movement.

Yesterday's market, the uninterest-
ing, was fairly strong in tone. Apex
was firm at 11 1/2, while a small lot of
Davidson changed hands at 77.

Extension met a little selling, which
caused the price to drop from 30 1/2
to 30, and Dome Lake eased
off to 30 1/2 again. Hollinger remained
steady at \$6.50.

The continued strength of McIntyre
was a notable feature, the stock closing
at 194 1/2. This stock is still ex-
dividend 5 per cent. Since going ex-
dividend the stock has more than
doubled its price.

From a reliable source that the com-
pany in February will make a very
good showing in the way of produc-
tion.

Vindex displayed a tendency to be-
come firmer following upon its reac-
tion over the week-end, advancing a
fraction from the opening to 52.

The stock was firm at Saturday's closing
bid of 52. West Dome changed
hands at 30.

Beaver was the feature of the silver
stocks, selling up again to 49, which
was Saturday's high. Reports from
the property on the find at the lower
contact are consistently good, and
would indicate that the life of this
property has unquestionably been pro-
longed by the policy of deep mining.

Timiskaming was firm at 5 1/2. Har-
graves was steady at 19. Pete Lake
advanced 1/4 to 11.

Silver Makes New Record

Silver was quoted yesterday at 78 1/2-8
cents per ounce, an advance of 3-4
cents Saturday's quotation, and the
highest point reached for twenty-four
years. The high record during 1916
was at 77 3/8.

It was in March, 1893, that the Sher-
man Act, which provided for the
monthly output of 4,000,000 ounces
of silver was repealed. The Sherman
measure was enacted to meet the de-
mand of the free silver circulation that
there should be a large circulation of
silver dollars. The enactment of the
Sherman measure resulted naturally in
a great drain on the available supply of
silver, and prices advanced sharply.

At one time the metal was quoted as
high as \$1.25 an ounce. When the law
was repealed in 1893 and the govern-
ment authorized buying unlimited quan-
tities of silver, prices steadily de-
clined and after falling below the pre-
sent level in March, 1893, quotations
never again reached that point until
the present time.

FINE LOOKING SAMPLE
FROM BEAVER STRIKE

A large section of the vein of high
grade ore recently struck on the Beaver
at the lower contact was received by
Manager P. L. Oliver yesterday. Al-
though no assay returns have been made yet,
judging from the character of the
sample, the values should run over nine
in places, the vein is over nine
inches in width, and the whole is
heavily impregnated with native silver.

TWIN CITY EARNINGS.

For the third week of January the earn-
ings of the Twin City Rapid Transit Co.
were \$131,545, an increase over the cor-
responding period last year of \$156, or
2.4 per cent. The small increase was
accounted for by an extraordinary snow storm
on January 21, when 16 inches of snow
fell in 24 hours.
