WHITE BEAR BAY, a small fishing settlement in Burgeo and La Poile district; a telegraph office; all other connections at or the same as Burgeo; very few inhabitants in summer, but in winter families move in from harbors on the coast. There are large quantities of pine lumber here, and it is the home of the deer. Population 35.

WHITE ROCK, a small settlement in Bonavista district; all connections at or the same as Brooklyn.

WHITE ROCK, a post, lumbering, fishing, farming and shipbuilding settlement in District of Trinity; nearest money order office Britannia Cove; port of entry and coastal steamer Trinity; all other connections at or the same as Shoal Harbor, 9 miles; contains 3 stores, 1 church; good harbor with safe entrance; population 175.

WICKLOW, a farming settlement and country road, in Harbor Main district; all connections at or the same as Holyrood (south); population 50.

WILD BIGHT (Notre Dame Bay), a way office, fishing and farming settlement in Twillingate district; nearest money order, telegraph, port of entry, coastal steamer Little Bay, 6 miles; railway Norris Arm; contains 1 store, 1 church and school; population 80.

WILD COVE, (on Fogo Island), a fishing settlement in Fogo district; all connections at or the same as Seldom-Come-Bye; contains 1 church and school house; population 63.

WILD COVE (Twillingate, South Island), a fishing settlement in Twillingate district; all connections at or the same as Morton's Harbor.

WILD COVE, BIG and LITTLE (Twillingate, North Island), fishing and farming settlements in Twillingate district; all connections at or the same as Twillingate (North Side); a hospital is situated at Wild Cove; population 200.

WITLESS BAY (including Gallows Cove), a post, money order, telegraph, fishing, farming and shipbuilding settlement in Ferryland district; nearest port of entry and railway station St. John's, 22 miles; S. S. connections at St. John's, connected by
