What his friends believed to be the more creditable explanation of his death was that in one of the spells of somnambulism to which he was subject he walked to the window, the sill of which was only eighteen inches above the floor, and toppled over it. He just missed being impaled on the spikes of a fence between the apartment house in which he lived and the one next door.

Dr. John Van Doren, who lived in the same house, was called by Mrs. Margaret Wonderman, superintendent of the building, and said that Mr. Warren had been dead some time. The body was later taken to the apartment and examined by Dr. Thomas A. Gonzales, assistant medical examiner, who also talked with Whitney Warren, when he arrived a short time after being informed of his brothers death.

"He had everything in the world to live for—plenty of money, a great devotion to his art for which he was ready to make all sorts of sacrifices, and did, and I am sure he would not have deliberately killed himself," said Whitney Warren. "My brother was somewhat afflicted with somnambulism, and I know that he has set up in bed rerently talking of the auto accident in which he was hurt in Italy. 


