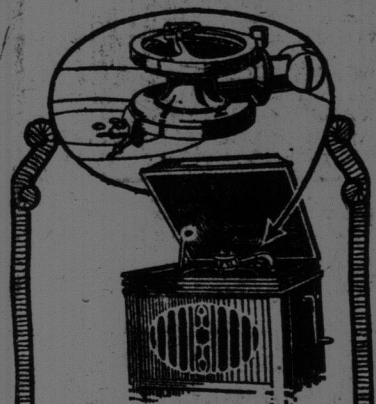

### Policeman Jumps 20 Feet in Pursuit Of Fallen Burglar

Three Others Are Caught After Struggle in Dark in Basement of School at Hammer-smith, London.

New York, June 22.—Patrolman Peter A. Clinton was indicted for manslaughter and assault in connection with the clubbing of Thaddeus Lynch, who later died in Bellevue Hospital, and William Ahearn, who was severely

### FOUR CHILDREN DROWN; MATES SHOW HEROISM

Pair Die as Boatload Spills at South Boston—Five are Rescued—Boys, 10 and 15, in Brave Attempts.

(Boston Herald)

Four children, none of them more than 15 years old, lost their lives yesterday in drowning accidents in Greater Boston. The drowning of three of them brought out unusual feats of heroism from other children no older. Two of the fatalities occurred in Reserve channel, South Boston, another in the Charles river between Newton and Watertown, and the third in the Charles river basin, Cambridge.

It was the old trick of "rocking the boat" that caused the two deaths in South Boston, and almost cost the lives of five other children. Philip Anastasio, 15, of 880 First street, South Boston, disobeyed his elder brother, took a pair of oars and invited several of his chums to go on a boat ride.

Save Five Children.

The youthful party was about 75 yards off the plant of the Walworth Manufacturing Company, when too much mercuric overturned the boat and all were thrown into the water. Anna Klunker, 15, of 8 City Point court, and Louis Jacobson, 15, of 6 City Point court, South Boston were drowned.

The cries of the others attracted the attention of Francis Alcey, 15, of 18 O street, and James Wilson, 15, of 18 City Point court, who swam out and seized Mary Klunker, 11, and Lillian Jacobson, 13. The two youths held the girls afloat, until more assistance arrived.

J. J. Duffy, of 185 West Brookline street, South end, and M. F. Duffy, who were sailing on their yacht Lone Star, dived overboard and rescued Fred Jacobson, 15, and Philip Anastasio, 15, of 2 Kimball place.

Another rescuer who swam out was Andrew Logan of Springfield street, South Boston. He seized Lillian Jacobson and her brother Louis, but the boy put up such a strenuous fight that he slipped from Logan's grasp and sank. Anna Klunker apparently was drowned before assistance arrived. The South Boston police recovered Anna's body, but are still searching for that of Louis Jacobson.

Try To Swim Charles.

The other drowning occurred when several Newton children attempted to swim from the Newton to the Watertown side of the Charles river, off the foot of Albemarle street, Newton. The youth drowned was Dominic Jerald, 14, of 22 Army street, West Newton.

The group of children had almost reached the Watertown side of the river when Dominic became exhausted and sank. Instead of becoming panic stricken, the others, although tired out by their swim, dived again and again in the hope of saving their companion.

Finally, fully 20 minutes after the accident, Francis McDonald, 15, of 28 Faxon street brought the body to the surface. Chief O'Hara of the Watertown fire department tried to revive the lad with a pulmonary, but his efforts were of no avail.

Frank Devine, 9, of 116 Broadway, Cambridge, was drowned yesterday afternoon in Charles River basin, near

**CHILDERS LEFT \$9,972**

Irish Rebel Made Will Four Days Before Execution.

London, May 22.—(By Mail).—Robert Erskine Childers, of Bushy Park road, Rathgar, Dublin, described in his will as "Staff Captain, Irish Republican Army," who, in the official wording of the grant of probate, is stated to have "died at Beggars Bush Barracks, Dublin," on November 24 last, left personal estate in the United Kingdom valued at £9,972, of which the personal estate in England amounts to £2,428. His will was made four days before his execution.

**CLUBBING**

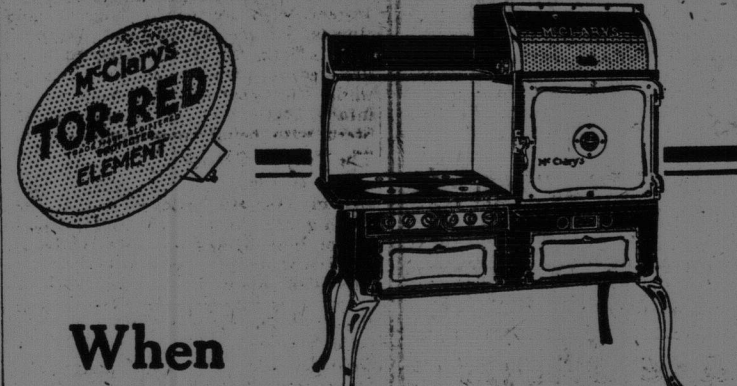
The clubbing was brought to the attention of Mayor Hyman last week by Assemblyman Louis A. Cuvillier. It was also reported to the District Attorney and an investigation had been under way for several days by Assistant District Attorney Morgan A. Jones of the homicide bureau.

**Storing of the Clubbing.**

Lynch and Ahearn, according to the stories of witnesses, were passing a barber shop at 1,499 Lexington Avenue on the afternoon of June 12, when they saw a truck belonging to the Van Buren Bill Postage Company, with a uniformed policeman on the driver's seat. The policeman was Clinton, who had been assigned to strike duty for the company. Ahearn declared that neither he nor Lynch knew that there was a strike on, but that Lynch, in passing, called: "What do you say to a ride?" Clinton's answer, it is charged, was a terrific blow. Ahearn charges that the policeman hit both Lynch and himself several times with a club, and that Lynch, after being kept in the police station for four hours, was taken to Bellevue dying.
