Mrs. Deborah Knox Livingstone Addresses Large Gathering in Interests of Local Campaign

Mrs. Deborah Knox Livingstone, a national officer of the W. C. T. U., addressed a mass meeting in the York theatre last evening taking as her subject The Challenge of the Liquor Traffic by the Church of Today.

"I don't know your conditions here," said Mrs. Livingstone, "but at home we have to go up against the big grafters. If you are going to drive the saloons out of this city you have a big job, a job worthy of any man's mettle. When you fight your brewer, your transporter, your importer and your exporter you have a strong combination—in fact the government of your country."

"Let me tell you we are on the popular side now. We have moved our headquarters to Washington. The president is a Presbyterian elder and a total abstainer, the vice-president is a Presbyterian elder and a total abstainer, and our secretary of state, William Jennings Bryan, God bless him, is a Methodist elder and a total abstainer, and everything else that is good and true in the cause of temperance."
