

Q 2 - Had you seen both of the accused soldiers before this night?

A 3 - Yes. They said I must have sexual intercourse with him.

Q 4 - In whose house were you sleeping when awakened?

A 4 - The house of my Father Eilert Wubbenhorst.

Both of the accused declined to question the witness.

SECOND WITNESS:

I, Eilert Wubbenhorst, living in Tannhausen, Kreis Aurich having been duly sworn state:

At approx 0200 hrs 21 Sep 45 I was in bed at my home and was awakened by a knocking at the door. I called to my daughter to go and see who was there. After a few minutes my daughter started for the door but before she reached it the outside door was broken open. Then before my daughter reached the inner or kitchen door it was also forced open. The accused (Hull and two soldiers came into the room. The accused Hull followed my daughter into her bedroom. A second soldier looked around while a third remained by the kitchen door. I told the accused Hull and my daughter that they should go outside which they did. About half an hour afterwards I heard a few shots.

Questions by the Officer taking the Summary.

Q 1 - How were the doors fastened?

A 1 - By a bolt.

Q 2 - Who locked the doors?

A 2 - I locked the doors before going to bed.

Both the accused declined to cross examine this witness
