SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE IN THE CASE OF THE ACCUSED NO. B-25524 SPR. MCPHEE R.M. R.C.E. C.E.T.C. (A5) A SOLDIER OF THE CAN-ADIAN ARMY PLACED ON ACTIVE SERVICE. CHARGES-1. Deserting His Majesty's Service. 2. Losing by neglect his clothing and regimental necessaries. FIRST WITNESS-Lieut J.D. McKichan R.C.E. C.E.T.C. (A5) having been duly sworn, states as follows:
I am the Officer in Charge of Records C.E.T.C. (A5).

I produce the following documents relating to the Accused and offer them as Exhibits numbered as follows:-Exhibit "A" - Extract from R.C.E.T.C. (A5) Part 2 Orders No. 196 dated the 18th day of August 1941, which shows the Accused to have been absent without leave one day by the 18th day of August 1941. Exhibit "B" - Declaration of a Court of Inquiry showing the Accused to have absented himself from Petawawa Military Camp at 2230 hrs on the 16th day of August 1941 and to have been still absent on the 9th day of September 1941 and that the Accused was deficient in Kit at this time. Exhibit "C" - Certificate of Apprehension signed by
Major H.C. Witthun No. 31 Company C.P.C.,
showing the accused to have been apprehended,
in civilian clothes, at 1530hrs the 10th
day of August 1942 at 591 College Street Toronto Ontario. Exhibit "D" - Certificate of Cost of Apprehension, signed by Major S. SAnderson R.C.A.S.C. C.S. and T.O. Petawawa Military Camp, to show that the cost of apprehension of the Accused was \$20.56. (The above documents were read to the Accused.) This concludes my evidence. Lieut. J.D. McKichan R.C.E. C.E.T.C. (A5) Officer in Charge of Records. The Accused declined to cross examine the witness. R.P. 83(b) observed.
