Some of the Terms.

H a majority of those voting mark "yes" on their ballots on April 18, it will, on proclamation by the governor general be illegal for any person to "import or bring into the province any liquor for beverage purposes."

"To agree with any person so to do or, to convey any such flour even through the province to another place unless by a common carrier, and then the container must not be opened within the province."
