

Knor Church Stratford Auxiliary W. J. M. S.*Secretary's Report for the year 1893.*

In submitting the annual report of the Auxiliary, it is most gratifying to notice the continued prosperity of the society during the past year. The membership has increased, three new members having been added to our numbers. We have eight members of General Society. The average attendance of members at our meetings has also increased. Last year it was fourteen, this year it has been sixteen. We have lost two members—one by removal from the city, the other by death. Our annual thank offering meeting held in December was well attended and much enjoyed. The thank offering amounted to \$39.10. This, together with our monthly contributions, reached a total of \$156.00. This sum has been raised by voluntary contributions of the members of the Auxiliary. Besides this, money and clothing to the value of \$93.85 was raised for the Indians of the Northwest Territories.
