S. of Lieut.-Col. John H. Kaulback, High Sheriff of Lunenburg, N.S.; and grandson of Henry Kaulback, Esq., who was High Sheriff of same county for an extended period. B. at Lunenburg, 1830. Ed. in N.S. and at Harvard University, where he graduated LLB. M., 1858, Eunice Sophie, only child of the late John Harris, Esq., of "Thornhill," Kings, N.S. Called to the Bar, N.S., 1855. Created a Q.C., 1873. Was for some years a mem. of Central Board of Agriculture, and commanded the first regiment of militia and volunteer artillery in his native town. Sat for Lunenburg in N.S. Assembly, from 1863 until the Union, when he was defeated as a candidate for House of Commons. Called to the Senate, 27 March, 1872. A Conservative, and has always been a steady and reliable Unionist. — *Kings St., Lunenburg, N.S.*
