perty; thence north-west, to the property of John Lambie, following the rear and north-east side line of the said property to the summit of the hill fronting the Biver St. Lawrence; thence north-east, following the summit of the said hill to the south-west line of the property of William, William E., and David E. Price; thence south, to the end of its depth; thence north-east, to the north-east line of the said property; thence north-west, to the property of James Reekie, following the rear and north-east line of the said property to the summit of the hill; thence north-east, following the said summit of the hill to the south-west line of the property of E. A. Coxworthy; thence south, to the end of its depth; thence north-east to the north-east line of the said property; thence north-west, to the summit of the said hill, following the said summit to the south-west line of the property of William Chapman; thence south, following the south-west summit of the hill or road to the south-west line of the property of E. A. Coxworthy; thence south, to the end of its depth; thence north-east, to the south-west line of A. C. Lemieux; thence north west, to the summit of the hill fronting the River St. Lawrence; thence north-cast, following the said summit to the south-west line of James Tibbits; thence south, to the end of its depth; thence north-east, to the north-east line of the said property; thence north-west, to the summit of the said hill; thence north-east, following the said summit to the south-west line of the property of John Davidson; thence south, to the end of its depth; thence north-east, to the north-east line of the said property; thence north-west, following the said line to the summit of the said hill ; thence north-east, following the north-west side of Davidson's Hill, to the south-west line of George Couture; thence north-west, to the point of departure ;-- together with all that part of the River St. Lawrence in front of the said tract of ground covered by forty feet of water, at lowest tides, comprised in the said Parish.
