Fishers Grant-Indian Reserve

Sir

I have the honor to forward herewith a conveyance to Her Majesty from Robert-P. Fraser & Co and I am to point out that Mess Stewart & Lamer in drawing up the deed represented Her Majesty in the deed by the Minister of the Interior instead of the Superintendent General of Indian Affairs. I know of no way of rectifying this as the interest of the grantors has been conveyed to Her Majesty by the present deed and consequently a new conveyance from them would convey nothing. The title however is now in Her Majesty. I also transmit file no 6079 of 83 of your Department, and a Certificate for \$17⁰⁰ in favor of Mess Stewart & Lamer for their services in connection with the matter
