	21-12-42		At 0815 hours ceiling 4000 feet visibility 10 miles, weather hazy, dual flying, wind 190 degrees. Flying washed in at 0830 hours and washed out at 1130 hours. Snowflurries. Flying washed in at 1415 hours and washed out at 1730 hours. 2 hours dual, 4 1/4 hours solo, total 6 1/4 hours. Night flying from 1900 hours to 0500 hours. Total flying time 405.20 hours.	
	22-12-42		At 0815 hours ceiling 7000 feet visibility 10 miles, hazy all around, dual flying, wind 180 degrees at 10 M.P.H. Flying washed in at 0830 hours and washed out at 1130 hours, rain with snow. Flying washed in at 1430 hours and washed out at 1700 hours. 5 1/2 hours dual flying only. Total flying time 193.20 hours.	
	23-12-42		Wives and children of the airmen were entertained by the officers and warrant officers' wives in Barrie. Various committees in connection were convened by Mrs. Edwards, wife of the commanding officer. Approximately one hundred children were presented with gifts by Santa Claus in appropriate flying suit after which tea and lunch was served. The Town Hall was heated and donated by the Town of Barrie for the occasion. At 0830 hours ceiling 2000 feet visibility 10 miles, weather hazy, dual flying. Flying washed in at 0830 hours and washed out at 1730 hours. 1 1/2 hours dual and 7 1/2 hours solo, total 9 hours. Night flying 2 hours, rain and fog. Total flying time 269.45 hours.
