WHEREAS The Unemployment Relief and Assistance Act, 1936, empowers His Excellency the Governor in Council to enter into agreements with any of the provinces respecting relief measures therein and provides for any payments on account of such relief measures to be made out of moneys appropriated for relief purposes by Parliament for the fiscal year ending March 31, 1937;

AND WHEREAS the Province has made certain proposals to initiate and execute a project for the conservation of its timber resources hereinafter described as works suitable for the employment of single homeless unemployed men and as supplemental to the Farm Employment project presently in effect;

AND WHEREAS the Province, for the purpose of obtaining financial assistance in the initiation and execution of the aforesaid project has requested His Excellency the
