the measurement of the 49 pieces  
 $12 \times 12 = 1436$  cubic feet.

You will also explain by  
what authority you reduced the rate  
of dues on <sup>the</sup> timber mentioned on  
the 1<sup>st</sup> page of your Return or you  
cannot in any case change the  
rate of dues without special instruc-  
tions from the department to do so.  
Small round timber must be Re-  
turned the same as the Saw logs  
on sheet number 2, and the  
rate of dues will be the same - and  
the round Timber for which you  
have charged at the rate of \$10<sup>00</sup>  
per cubic foot (which no doubt means  
per 1000 cubic feet) must also be  
charged as Saw logs or as Burn Timber
