

that it would be possible to increase the attendance at the boys school to 40 as you did from the 1st July 1892 and an item of \$900⁰⁰ to provide for the same was included in the supplementary Estimates but to the regret of the Department it was disallowed by the Treasury and it will therefore not be paid to pay any more than the usual grant for 1892-93

An effort will be made to have the additional amount provided for the year 1893-94.

Every possible care is taken to meet your wishes as regards the increased grant for the current year.
