Re: 1954 Annuity Payments

Further to your letter of April 20th we have received the advance to pay annuities to Treaty #3, #5 and #9. The \$6,000.00 advance to pay Treaty #3 annuities also includes the amount of \$1,300.00 to pay annuities to members of the Grassy Narrows Band. Since this Band was transferred to the Kenera Indian Agency effective May 1st the advance of \$1,300.00 should be made available to Superintendent N. Paterson who will be making payments to this Band on June 9th. Please advise if we should issue a cheque to Superintendent Paterson for the amount of \$1,300,00 to enable him to make these payments.

When replying please advise the number of the cheque

for amount of \$25,500.00 as this will be required later when we account for the advances.
