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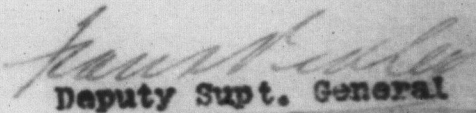

Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 18th instant, I beg to say that the Department approves of your accepting Messrs Maunsell Bros offer to supply beef cows and steers on foot, which are running on the reserve under grazing rights, upon the understanding that you are to do the picking and slaughtering. Dressed beef for months of July and August 8 ¢ per lb. September up to 31st December \$5.75 per 100 lbs. January to end of June 7 ¢ per lb. No stipulated quantity to be furnished but as much as you require to be supplied at any time at the above rates during the periods mentioned.
