Referring to official letter of November 7th, last, in reference to the discharge of Paul Low Horn from the St. Joseph's Industrial School I beg to say that when authority for the discharge was given the Department was not aware that the boy was on the reserve. As a matter of discipline it must insist upon his being returned to the school and discharged in the regular way. Arrangements have been made for his final discharge on the 1st of March, next. You will be good enough, therefore, to see that the boy is returned to the school at once to remain there until that date.
