No. 50. Secret. Your telegram of the 11th May,  
No. 70. Following from Prime Minister for your Prime  
Minister, Begins:

We are most grateful for offer of Canadian Government  
to despatch a battalion for service in the West Indies.  
We much appreciate this further evidence of Canada's  
determination to play her full part and gladly accept  
offer. As regards the last part of your message, the  
United Kingdom military staff are in touch with Canadian  
military authorities as to detailed arrangements. Ends.
