

No. 9. Seikat - on the Niemin-Niota Trail
about 7 miles from the junction of the Thompson
and Niemin Rivers.

No. 10. Squiamy on the Squiamy Stream on
the mountain above the "Mudslide".

No. 11. Enhelt on the mountain above the Mudslide
on the Jackson Stream.

No. 12. Kaynawicht - on the Niemin-Cook's Ferry
Trail about 22 miles from the junction of the
Thompson and Niemin Rivers.

No. 13. Naykikoult - on the Left Bank of the
Niema River below and adjacent to the
Jackson Reserve.

Sathwa - on the Right Bank of the Thompson
River nearly opposite the 6 1/2 mile post.

Shonakht - on the Right Bank of the Thompson
River at the mouth of the Shonakht Stream.

Water Privileges set apart for the Niemin Indian
are as follows:

* 50 inches of water from the Naykikoult
Stream

* 75 inches from the Kaynawicht Stream.

* 50 inches from a small Lake at Enhelt
Reserve and from a stream flowing south -

eastward to Seikat, now used by Frank an Indian
* 200 inches from three lakes about three miles
south
