



## KELOWNA

Kelowna has a population in town and district estimated at 5,000.

Is about 20 hours from Vancouver and 96 hours from Montreal.

Has its own water, light, power and sewerage systems.

Has many miles of interesting drives.

Has a telephone system with rural and long distance connections.

Has a number of shipping organizations, facilitating sale of fruit and produce.

Has three banks, mercantile houses of all classes, two newspapers, five churches, three schools with sixteen teachers, and all the prominent fraternal organizations.

Rates : -

Water for domestic purposes \$1.35 per month per 4,000 gallons.

Light, 13½ cents per K.W. hour.

Power, 9 cents per K.W. hour.

Taxes based on land only, 30.4 mills.

Rents range from \$8 to \$25 per month. Residential lots sell at prices ranging from \$50 to \$500.
