caused by sudden chill, foreign bodies in windpipe, micro organisms, or it may be associated with influenza, glanders, hing fever, etc.

SYMPTOMS: Sore throat, loss of appetite, thirst, animal appears dull, membranes of the mouth, eyes and nose are reddened; urine is scanty and highly colored; cough dry and husky. After two or three days the

cough becomes looser and a frothy, sticky mucus of a yellowish color is present. This gradually becomes puslike, after which the animal seems somewhat relieved. In the first stages the pulse is soft and weak, but frequently the temperature is high, ranging from 105° F.
