WHEREAS the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of this Island stands Pro-
rogued until Wednesday the Thirteenth day of August inst: And
Whereas I think fit further to Prorogue the said General Assembly until
Wednesday the 15th day of October next.

I do, therefore, by this my Proclamation, Prorogue the said GENERAL
ASSEMBLY until Wednesday the 15th day of October next. And all
Persons concerned are required and commanded to take due notice and
govern themselves accordingly.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at the Gov-
ernment House, at St. John's, the 7th day of
August, 1845, in the 9th Year of Her Ma-
jesty's Reign.
