BOON TO WORKING MEN. German Cities Build Summ Houses on Vacant Land.

A sarcastic foreigner once remarked that the only colonies of any use to Germany were her "Lauben" (arbor colonies.) These are collections of summer houses with a few square feet of land attached to them, to be found on the outskirts of practically all large German towns. Taken singly each small hut reminds one of the summer houses run up in American or small hut reminds one of the summer houses run up in American or English gardens by the wholly unskilled householder in his leisure moments, while all together they give the appearance of a vast gypsy encampment. In truth they are an enormous and highly prized boon to the working classes of the cities and towns. 


