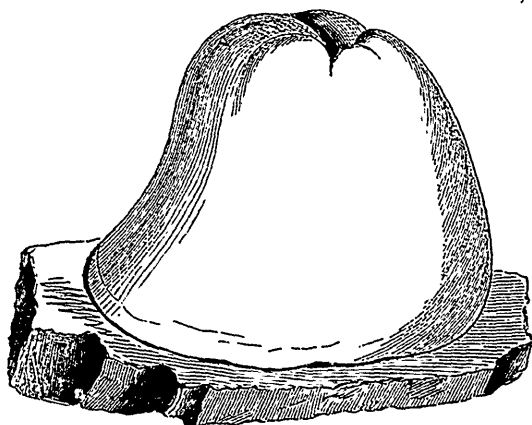


Fig. 1.—*Actinia Dianthus*. Contracted.
