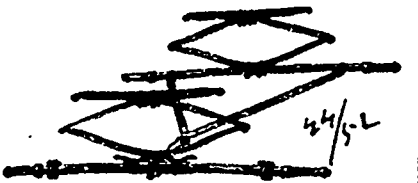

Scientific and Useful.

FILLING FOR JELLY CAKE.—Fine apple sauce, sweetened more than usual, and flavoured with lemon essence, makes nice filling for a jelly cake.

CASTOR OIL FOR SHOES.—Take a teaspoonful of it, and rub it thoroughly by a fire. Do this when the shoes are new, and several times afterward, and they will last twice as long.

SALMON BALLS OR CROQUETTES.—Half a can of salmon chopped with some cold boiled potatoes and a hard boiled egg. Season with pepper and salt, make into round balls or cakes, roll in beaten egg, and fry a light brown.

TO DRIVE AWAY RATS.—Take chloride of lime as an infallible preventive. Rats flee from its odour as from a pestilence. It should be thrown into their holes, and spread about wherever they are likely to come. It should be renewed once a fortnight.

STEWED CHEESE.—Set a little bucket containing a pint of milk into a pot of hot water until it begins to boil; then cut up the cheese and add with it a piece of butter and some pepper and salt. As soon as the cheese is melted, pour it over a slice or two of toast.

EASY MUFFINS.—Two cups milk, two cups flour, two eggs beaten very light and put in last, with just a little sugar. Have the muffin pan well greased hot on the stove, pour in the butter and set in a hot oven, they will be golden puffs when they are done, and they are delicious with coffee.

FRIED TROUT.—Small brook trout may be cooked to perfection with the greatest ease in a kettle of deep fat. They will be a clear golden brown in colour, crisp and delicious in flavour, and there is no danger of breaking or "mussing" them in cooking. This is the very best way of cooking any small fish.

CREAM PUFFS: One pint boiling water—white boiling stir in one cupful of butter, two heaping cups of flour and eight eggs, yolk and whites beaten separately. Stir until well mixed, then take off the fire. When cold stir in one teaspoonful of soda. Now drop in gem pans and bake in hot oven.

RICE PUDDING.—One-half cupful of rice, three-fourths of a pint of milk, four apples, peeled, cored and stewed, one-third cupful of sugar, four eggs. Boil rice in milk until reduced to pulp, beat well with apple sauce and sugar for ten minutes, then set aside to cool; then carefully mix in the whites of eggs whipped to a stiff froth; butter the mould pour in pudding, set in saucepan with boiling water to reach half up its side; steam slowly for twenty-five minutes; permit it to stand three minutes before turning out.

TIME TABLE FOR COOKING.—Onions, medium size, one hour. Green corn, twenty to twenty-five minutes. Peas and asparagus, twenty to twenty-five minutes. Potatoes, half an hour, unless small, when rather less. Cabbage and cauliflower, twenty five minutes to half an hour. Carrots and turnips, forty-five minutes when young; one hour in winter. Lima beans, if young, half an hour; old, forty to forty-five minutes. Beets, one hour in summer; one hour and a half, or even two hours, if large, in winter. String beans, if slit or sliced slantways and thin, twenty-five minutes; if only snapped across, forty minutes.

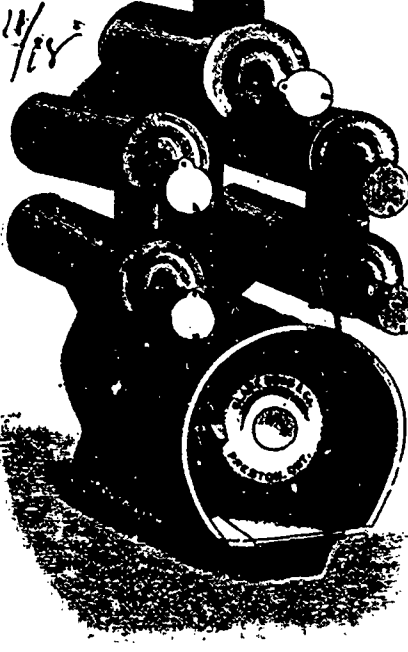
CREAM OF CAULIFLOWER.—From a cauliflower boiled tender, trim off the superfluous stalks and enough of the least fine flowerets to make a cupful; chop it and rub it through a sieve with a potato masher. For two quarts of cream soup, put in a thick saucepan two tablespoonfuls each of butter and flour, and stir them over the fire until free from lumps; then stir in a quart each of hot water and milk, adding them half a cupful at a time, and stirring that quantity quite smooth before putting in any more; when all is smoothly blended, season the soup palatably with salt, white pepper, and very little grated nutmeg; stir in the pulp of the cauliflower, let the soup boil once and then serve it.
