MDA AND AVEO TECH OF CANADA, ONLY FIRMS SELECTED TO SUBMIT FINAL COSTED PROPOSALS.

GUIDANCE IN PREPARATION OF OFFSETS PACKAGE, VISIT CANADAIR MONTREAL TO DISCUSS APPROPRIATE METHODS OF PROMOTION. CHALLENGER CONSIDERED PRIME CON-TENDER
